

# Contact tracing 101.

Member of the Yale community is tested for COVID-19 infection. **Result is positive.**

Result goes to **primary healthcare provider**, who contacts the patient. Patient is asked to self-isolate and is provided with additional guidance and referrals.

Patient is contacted by the **Yale Contact Tracing Team (YCTT)**.

Patient may be contacted by their **local health department**.

Campus-based close contacts of the patient (whose privacy will be respected) are identified and notified by YCTT of possible exposure.

Community-based close contacts of the patient may also be identified and notified by their **local health department** of possible exposure.

Partially or unvaccinated close contacts are referred for testing and advised to self-quarantine for 10 days and monitor symptoms.

Vaccinated close contacts are referred for testing and advised to monitor symptoms.
